Social Work Parallel Program

Edison Community College / Wright State University

Students who complete the **Ohio Transfer Module** and an **AAS degree** in Social Services at Edison Community College may transfer into the Social Work B.A. program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AAS.

Students should also complete the additional courses at Edison Community College in order to meet admission requirements for the B.A. in Social Work at Wright State University:

ECO 120S & PLS 121S (take for social science portion of Ohio Transfer Module)

COM 228S

BIO 121S & 122S (take for natural science portion of the Ohio Transfer Module)

Students are encouraged to take the following courses while at Edison Community College:

Complete Foreign Language Sequence 121S, 122S, 221S, & 222S

Admission Requirements to Social Work Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.25
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 121S & 122S
3. Grade of "C" or better in SSV 111S, 113S, & 211S
4. Official application to the Social Work program by February 1st for fall admission

Additional Information


All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 42 semester hours of courses at the 3000/4000 level.

Admission to the Social Work program is competitive. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the major. Applications can be found at http://www.wright.edu/cola/Dept/social_work/admissions.htm.
