E. Review/Revision Provisions

1. This Agreement will automatically renew unless superseded by a new Agreement. Either institution may terminate this agreement at any time by written notice at least one (1) year in advance of the effective termination date. Should the Agreement be terminated, it is understood that the termination will not apply to students already accepted by Springfield College under the terms of the Agreement, but not yet enrolled in classes.
2. Substantive changes in the courses or programs of either institution will involve discussions between representatives of Springfield College and **Horry-Georgetown Technical College**. At the request of either party, review of the contents of implementation of this Agreement will be conducted by both institutions.
3. An annual review of this Agreement shall take place between **Horry-Georgetown Technical College** officials and Springfield College School of Human Services officials.

F. Assistance Provisions

1. **Horry-Georgetown Technical College** and Springfield College School of Human Services both agree to encourage qualified students to participate in the program by providing advising information and such other assistance necessary to assure an easy transition from **Horry-Georgetown Technical College** to Springfield College School of Human Services.
2. **Horry-Georgetown Technical College** and Springfield College School of Human Services agree to publicize this Agreement among their student, faculty, administration, and service community. The widest possible publicity will be given to the establishment and continuation of this Agreement. Information will be placed in publications, such as brochures, view books, student handbooks, descriptions in catalogs, newsletters, and other news media.
